

Swirling Waters or Bea's Jig

**a jig in 32 bars for 3 couples in a longwise set
recommended tune: The High Lodge (Muriel Johnston)**

- 1 - 4 1st and 2nd couple dance petronella turning and set
- 5 - 8 1st couple turn by the right hand three quarters and cast off one place finish facing in and down while 2nd couple turn by the right hand three quarters and cross up to top place finish facing out
- 9 - 16 2nd, 1st and 3rd couple dance a reel of three at the sideline
- 17 - 18 1st couple turn by the right hand three quarters
- 19 - 20 1st couple continue turning for another three quarters while the corners dance a quarter chase clockwise
- 21 - 22 1st couple continue turning half way round while the corners dance into the center to form a small circle with 1st couple, all facing clockwise. (1st couple drop hands at bar 22, 2nd man is now in front of 1st man while 3rd man is behind 1st man. 3rd lady is in front of 1st lady while 2nd lady is behind 1st lady)
- 23 - 24 All dance out to own sideline
- 25 - 32 2nd, 1st and 3rd couple dance six hands round to the left for six slip steps, then all pivot round (left shoulder back) and chase anticlockwise to own side

repeat having passed a couple
